



- •EUMEDCONNECT2 being planned



- Tele-medecine well established, Manila is involving all TEIN2 partners for first time

- EC is planning to fund TEIN3:
 - amount/period/terms to be confirmed (April 2007?)
 - *may* include funding for additional ASEM partners
- Bilateral discussions continuing with
 - TEIN2 partners (esp. non beneficiaries)
 - Other external funders
- TEIN3 being planned to follow TEIN2 seamlessly from cSept 2008:
 - Network will be re-tendered
 - Organisation transitioned to Asian ownership (close working with APAN)
